

TEAM PSYCHOLOGICAL SAFETY

No one likes to deliver bad news to their boss. But that's exactly what I had to do when a project I'd been working on wasn't delivering the results we expected. I'd been a big advocate for our team taking on the initiative and, personally, I'd invested a lot of time into it and convinced others to do the same.

when I met with my manager to present the data, which showed that we hadn't recouped our investment, and the initiative had performed worse than planned, I was nervous. I would've understood if he had been frustrated or even angry, and I expected him to at least ask, "What went wrong?" or "How could we have prevented this?" (Both questions I'd prepared answers for.) Instead, he just asked a simple question: "What did I learn?"

I was building psychological safety, and I understood that learning is key; our team's future performance depends on it. Psychological safety is a critical concept for teams and the people who lead them. But not everyone knows or fully understands it. Where did this term originate from? how it's evolved, and, of course, how people can think about building psychological safety on their own teams?

Let's start with a definition. Team psychological safety is a shared belief held by members of a team that it's OK to take risks, to express their ideas and concerns, to speak up with questions, and to admit mistakes all without fear of negative consequences.

The "team" in team psychological safety is important. This is a group-level phenomenon; it shapes the learning behaviour of the group, which in turn affects the team's performance and therefore organisational performance. The sense of safety and willingness to speak up is not an individual trait, even though it's something you do feel and experience at the individual level; "it's an emergent property of the group." In fact, in most studies, people who work closely together have similar levels of psychological safety compared to people in other teams.



Creating psychological safety in teams Psychological safety is the degree to which team members feel that their environment is supportive of asking for help, trying new things, and learning from mistakes.

Team leaders and members can promote psychological safety by:

- » Inviting input from all team members.
- » Encouraging team members to contribute.
- » Promoting active listening and learning from each other.
- » Acknowledging the limits of their own knowledge.
- » Celebrating failures, providing positive reinforcement for innovations, even though they don't always work.


